Texas 4-H Connect 2012 - 2013 4-H Year Enrollment!

Remember that starting November 1, 2012, the 4-H Connect Registration Fee will be \$25, so for those of you who have not re-enrolled/enrolled, please do so! All profiles were changed to INACTIVE on August 15th and you will be required to re-enroll for the 2012-2013, 4-H Year. All existing profiles (youth and adults) must be updated.

Please remember that all 4-H members must be officially enrolled in an "active" status on 4-H Connect to be considered an official 4-H member. It is very important that each 4-H member update their profile with the most current information.

Please be prepared to process payment through 4-H Connect with re-enrolling/enrolling your family profile.

IMPORTANT!

4-H Volunteer Enrollment Information

All volunteers must also enroll annually by creating or re-activating their profile in the 4-H CONNECT online management system. The volunteer must enroll as a 4-H volunteer every year. Enrollment and an active profile is required for any volunteer to register for an event in 4-H CONNECT.

Please note that you no longer need to submit the 4-H Volunteer Background Check form. Simply coordinate with the County Extension Office on the \$10 payment for screening or mail-in your check made payable to 4-H Project Account to this address: 410 North 13th Avenue/Edinburg, Texas 78541 or bring it by the Extension Office to Mary Patlan. The pending status on 4-H Connect will change automatically, as soon as it is approved from the State 4-H Office.

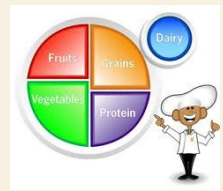

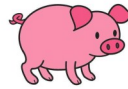

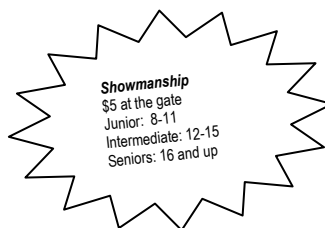

2013 Texas 4-H Photography Contest Rules & Guidelines

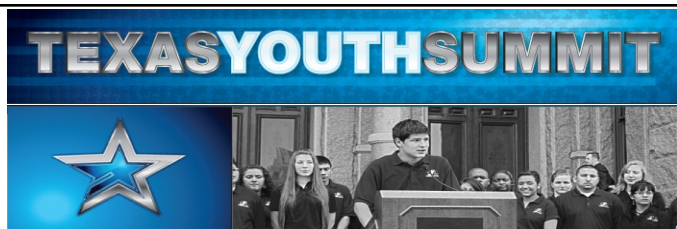

Some other highlights/changes to the 2013 contest include:

Theme category is "Holiday Season in Texas." This theme allows 4-H members to take photos of any holiday from January 1, 2012 to time of entry. The Holiday theme should have photographs depicting a Texas theme/flair or western heritage. Photographs can include nature, landscape, people, animals (domestic and wildlife), as long as the subject of the photo is clearly related to a holiday with a Texas/Western basis.

New Photography Activity Resource Pages

The Texas 4-H and Youth Development Program release three photography activity pieces that can be used in introducing and promoting the 4-H photography project. Activity sheets are categorized in beginning, intermediate, and advanced and are designed to engage 4-H and non-4-H members, to think about careers, education, and opportunities within the photography project. 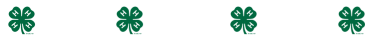
