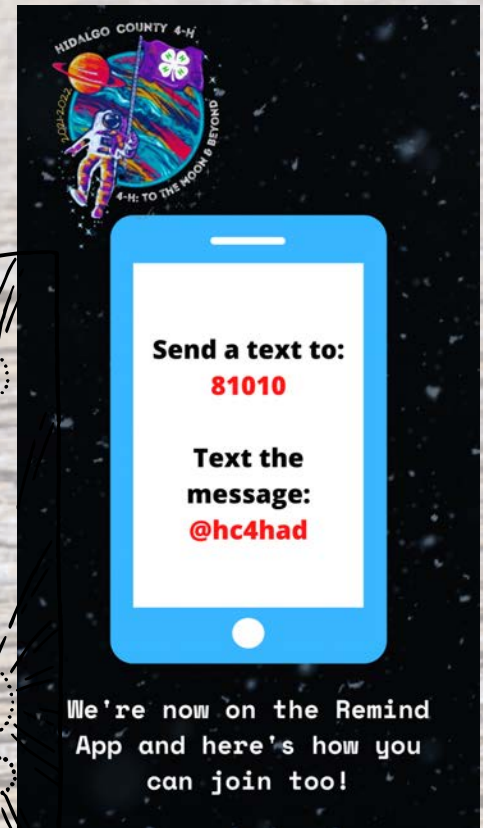
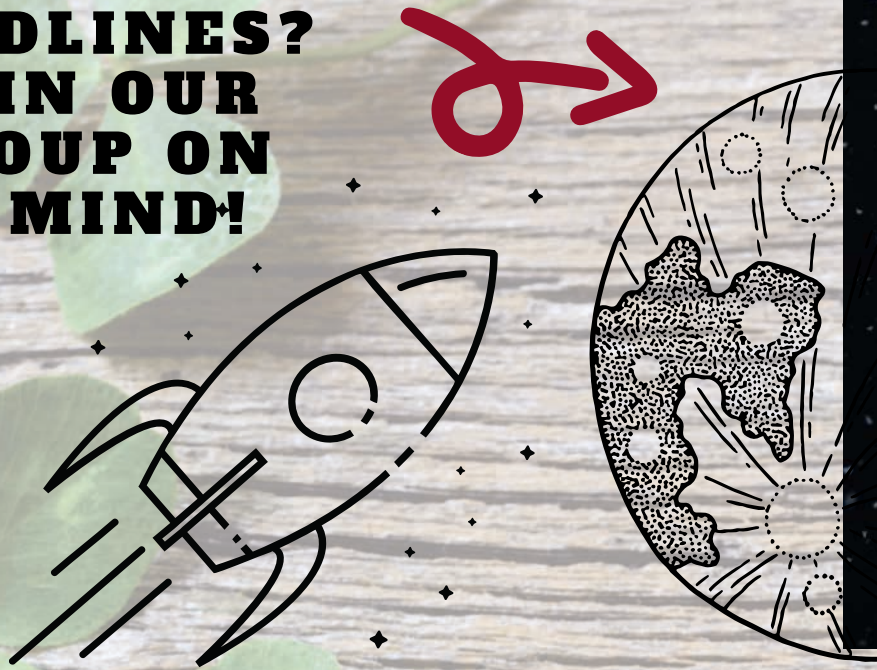

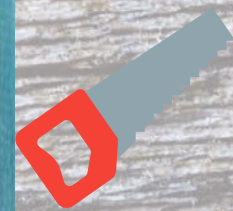

ATTENTION AG. SCIENCE TEACHERS AND COUNTY EXTENSION AGENTS!

This is to advise all involved in the supervision of youth who will be participating in the 2022 RGVLS that a team from the Texas Livestock Validation Program will be onsite during the livestock show in March. They will be checking all Junior Livestock entries in breeding and market shows against state validation records to ensure compliance. Secondly, they will also be collecting DNA, nose prints, and other identifying information as appropriate for all placing livestock during their respective shows. Finally, the state teams will be solely responsible for any re-tagging necessary on-site during the show for any Jr. livestock that arrive on the showgrounds without required validation tags. (validation chairmen/committees will not conduct re-tagging) Any entries found to not be in compliance with state validation guidelines will be subject to disqualification.

Please take all appropriate action to communicate this with your exhibitors as you deem necessary.

National 4-H Conference

MARCH 20-24, 2022 - WASHINGTON, D.C.

National 4-H Conference is a working conference in which 4-H youth (ages 15-19) and adults--at the invitation of the Secretary of Agriculture--assist in the development of recommendations to help guide 4-H Youth Development Programs nationally and in their communities. This event brings together youth, volunteer leaders, and state and county Extension staff members from across the United States, the U.S. Territories, and the Canadian Provinces.

As the sponsor for this conference, the National 4-H Headquarters--located within Families, 4-H, and Nutrition at the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA's) National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA)--is charged with sharing the recommendations that emerge from the conference with the Secretary of Agriculture, national Extension Program Leaders, and others who determine 4-H programs. Each delegate chooses an important societal topic to discuss in a roundtable situation with other delegates. From the roundtable discussion, the groups prepare a briefing to present to federal stakeholders. This experiential approach ensures that the conference is a meaningful experience for the youth and adult participants. Social activities in the evening, tours of Monuments and Museums and cultural entertainment round out the conference.

Texas 4-H Members:

As soon as we receive more details about the events location, what this year's "hybrid" format will look like, etc., we will post applications to attend on 4Honline.

Texas 4-H typically sends between 5-10 youth to this event. Estimated cost will be between \$2,000-3,000 per participant.


