- You are responsible for picking up all of your hulls.

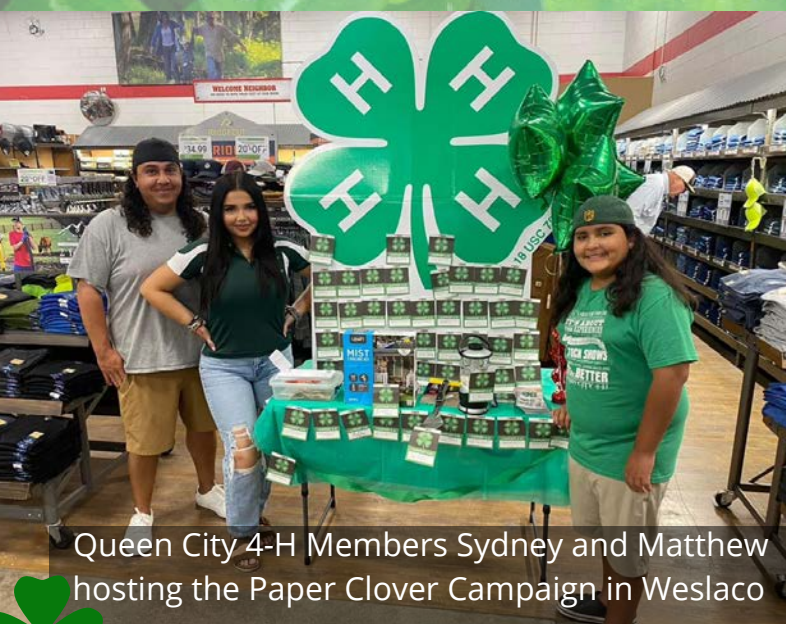

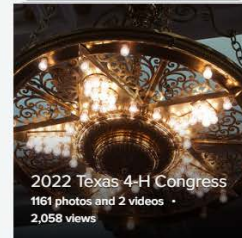


